June 24, 2020

Meeting Held VIA ZOOM.

Call to Order: All Board Members were in attendance via ZOOM.

Introduction: Bob Cannon, President, greeted everyone and explained the protocol of the meeting. The Agenda is available for everyone to follow on the screen.
