Thank you for your June 27, 2022, response to our letter of concern regarding the City of Phoenix Historic Preservation Office's handling of the application for an over-height fence in front of the historic home at 78 W. Cypress Street. This action, in our view, circumvented the City of Phoenix historic preservation process as well as the Willo Conservation Plan. We welcome your offer to meet with a few Willo Neighborhood Association Board members to talk through the issues. We request that representatives from Mayor Gallego's office and Vice Mayor Pastor's Office attend the meeting, as well as Helana Ruter, the acting Historic Preservation Officer.

The most convenient dates for our group to meet are during the first three weeks of August 2022. We look forward to hearing back from you and the opportunity to discuss this issue with an eye toward how similar mishaps can be avoided in the future.
