
Forget SoHo, We've Got SoWi!

conversation started on the Willo Facebook page about "South" Willo. As the conversation got sillier, there was talk about living in SoWi or NoWi or even SoEaWi (Southeast Willo) as if our neighborhood was divided into distinct sections, each with its own characteristics. Historically, however, the neighborhood we call Willo was built and sold as 22 separate subdivisions, shown on this map.

A LITTLE WHILE AGO. A

Most of the oldest homes were built in the southernmost subdivisions like North Chelsea, Latham Addition, and Las Palmas (SoEaWi), but there were also many homes built early on in the northern part of the neighborhood too. This 1930 aerial photo (the earliest available) shows a number of homes dotting the northern areas of Willo, while most of the area north of Vernon and



west of 5th Ave. was still farmland at this time. If you look closely at the photo, you can see the

houses of "Millionaires' Row" lining Central Ave. Most of these large lots extended west all the way to 1st Ave!

At the time these subdivisions were laid out and sold, they were well outside the city limits and were known as "streetcar suburbs" because a streetcar line ran up 5th Avenue to Encanto Blvd. Known as the #3 Kenilworth Line, it took residents back and forth to town before most people had

cars. Some routes ran until 1948, when the city stopped offering electrified trolley service in lieu of buses.

The Willo Historic District inventory sheet states that, while the area was developed subdivisions. as separate the layout of streets, size/ orientation of lots, and scale housing relatively of are consistent throughout, "giving the image of a unified historic neighborhood." Isn't it interesting and telling that Willo is also unified and cohesive in spirit?!



"DON GRAY PAINTED THE reality of everyday life with passion and seriousness. He described himself as a responder to the stimulus of the physical world, a lover of its color, substance, and solidity of form. In his still lifes and self-portraits, he responded to the mundane with extraordinary intensity; there is a constant tension between order, the control needed to create a sense of reality, and the emotion of the artist responding to the world. This concern was reflected in Gray's activities as an art critic, educator, and producermoderator of Manhattan Cable Television's "Artist and Critic."


